Something spooky going Down . . .

GHOSTLY goings-on at Down Hall Hotel have attracted so much public interest that the venue is planning a series of psychic dinners.

The old country house in Hatfield Heath, the earliest reference to which dates back to 1322, has a rich history as a private home, convalescent centre for soldiers wounded in the First World War, a school and an antiques complex.

Psychics Ryan Saunders and Polly Weeks first visited Down Hall to carry out a private investigation. They found so many interesting things that they got together with hotel staff to launch the psychic evenings, the first of which

is on March 27.

The purpose of the evenings is to investigate the history of Down Hall through psychics and their tools.

“We try to make the evening as entertaining, informative and interactive as possible,” said Ryan. “The use of pendulums and digital cameras are the only tools we need to demonstrate that the information is so very close and accessible to us.”
